From the first Biblical account of the creation of human beings:

καὶ ἐποίησεν τὸν ἄνθρωπον· κατ' εἰκόνα Θεοῦ ἐποίησεν αὐτόν· ἄρσεν καὶ θῆλυ
ἐποίησεν αὐτούς. καὶ εὐλόγησεν αὐτούς ὁ Θεὸς, <saying...> καὶ ἄρχετε τῶν ἰχθύων
τῆς θαλάσσης, καὶ τῶν πετεινῶν τοῦ οὐρανοῦ, καὶ πάντων τῶν κτηνῶν, καὶ πάσης
τῆς γῆς, καὶ πάντων τῶν ἔρπετῶν τῶν ἐρπόντων ἐπὶ τῆς γῆς. (LXX Γένεσις 1.26-28)
