

AGE 02 01: Verbs and Accents Worksheet

Review thoroughly the first page of the “Rule for Accents Verbs” handout (the section on Verbs and the Recessive Accent). Once this is done:

1. Provide the proper accents for the following verbs.

(Remember: if a Greek word ENDS in αι or οι, these particular diphthongs were considered short, not long, and so the verb was accented as though the ultima were short. This is quirk of these two diphthongs; all others, e.g. ει, remain long).

2. Cite the accent rule that you are applying in each situation. This can be done by giving the Arabic Numeral and, if applicable, the letter from the accents handout.

e.g. παυουσι: παύουσι (1)

(here, it is 1 because “1” states that “If a verb form has three or more syllables, and the ultima of the word contains a single short vowel, the accent recedes to the antepenult”)
